

Accreditation in a personality type questionnaire – the Majors PTI™

This course is for professionals who want to be accredited in the use of a questionnaire that accurately identifies Personality Types based on the work of C.G. Jung. The Majors PTI was developed to identify these 16 Types and related frameworks such as Keirseyan Temperament. Dr Mark Majors, the developer of the Majors PTI is a well-respected psychometrician, who worked on the MBTI revision resulting in the current Step I and Step II Forms. He is a co-author of the MBTI Step II Manual (2001).
